

1 General

- 1.1 These Rules are in addition to the Championship Rules.

2 The Junior Singles Championships – Men and Women

- 2.1 These Championships are open to all male and female members of Affiliated Clubs, who have not attained their 25th birthday on the 1st April in the year of the championship, and on payment of an entry fee, as determined at a General Meeting.
- 2.2 The game shall consist of 21 shots up and four bowls each player.
- 2.3 This entry must be forwarded directly to the appropriate Competition Secretary through the Club Secretary on the form provided by the Association.

3 The Singles Championships – Men and Women

- 3.1 The games shall consist of 21 shots up and four bowls each player.
- 3.2 These Championships are open to all male or female members of Affiliated Clubs on payment of an entry fee, as determined at a General Meeting, and which must be forwarded directly to the appropriate Competition Secretary through the Club Secretary on the form provided by the Association.

4 Two-Wood Singles (Women only)

- 4.1 Each game shall consist of 21 ends and two bowls each player.
- 4.2 This Championship is open to all female members of Affiliated Clubs on payment of an entry fee and green fee, as determined at a General Meeting, and which must be forwarded directly to the appropriate Competition Secretary through the Club Secretary on the form provided by the Association.

5 The Pairs Championship - Men and Women

- 5.1 The game shall consist of 21 ends and four bowls each player.
- 5.2 These Championships are open to all male or female members of Affiliated Clubs on payment of an entry fee, as determined at a General Meeting, and which must be forwarded directly to the appropriate Competition Secretary through the Club Secretary on the form provided by the Association.
- 5.3 The named player in the draw and one other player shall constitute the Pair and should normally play together throughout the championship.
- 5.4 One additional, and the same, player may be used as a substitute at any time, provided that player has not already played in the current championship.

6 Women's Junior Pairs (Players from the same County)

- 6.1 Each game shall consist of 18 ends and four bowls each player.
- 6.2 This Championship shall be open to all female Members of affiliated Clubs who have not attained their 25th birthday on the 1st April in the year of the Championship on payment of an entry fee, as determined at a General Meeting, and which must be forwarded directly to the appropriate Competition Secretary through the Club Secretary on the form provided by the Association.
- 6.3 The two players may belong to separate clubs within the same county, so long as both clubs are affiliated.

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- 6.4 The named player in the draw and one other player shall constitute the Pair and should normally play together throughout the championship.
- 6.5 One additional, and the same, player may be used as a substitute at any time, provided that player has not already played in the current championship.

7 The Triples Championship – Men and Women

- 7.1 The game shall consist of 18 ends and three bowls each player.
- 7.2 These championships are open to all male or female members of Affiliated Clubs on payment of an entry fee, as determined at a General Meeting, and which must be forwarded directly to the appropriate Competition Secretary through the Club Secretary on the form provided by the Association.
- 7.3 The named player in the draw and two other players shall constitute the Triple and should normally play together throughout the championship.
- 7.4 One additional, and the same, player may be used as a substitute at any time provided that the player has not already played in the current championship.

8 The Fours Championships – Men and Women

- 8.1 The game shall consist of 21 ends and two bowls each player.
- 8.2 These championships are open to all male and female members of Affiliated Clubs on payment of an entry fee, as determined at a General Meeting, and which must be forwarded directly to the appropriate Competition Secretary through the Club Secretary on the form provided by the Association.
- 8.3 The named player in the draw and three other players shall constitute the Four and should normally play together throughout the championship.
- 8.4 One additional, and the same, player may be used as a substitute at any time provided that the player has not already played in the current championship.
